

Air & Rail Travel Discounts

FILTECH 2016 will be held again at the the Koelnmesse in Cologne. Due to Koelnmesse's central location, which is conveniently situated for all transport links, visitors can quickly reach the exhibition centre by car, train and plane. High-speed ICE trains connect the airports in Frankfurt (FRA), Düsseldorf (DUS), Cologne/Bonn (CGN) directly to the exhibition center via Köln Messe/Deutz station.

If travelling by train from outside Germany, you can also take advantage of this reduced fare by booking this special ticket which is valid throughout Germany.

Arriving by the Deutsche Bahn (German Railways)
Cologne "Messe/Deutz" train station (Distance Koelnmesse: approx. 300m)

We recommend to arrive at Cologne "Messe/Deutz" train station. From there the Entrance East is approx. 5 minutes walk away. The "S-Bahn" lines S6, S11, S12 and S13 leave Cologne Main Station from platform 10 towards Cologne "Messe/Deutz" at regular intervals. This station is opposite the Koelnmesse (Entrance South).

Cologne Main Station (Distance Koelnmesse: approx. 1.5 km)
If your train arrives at Cologne Main Station, there are several ways to get from there to Koelnmesse:

The best way to travel from Cologne/Bonn, Düsseldorf and Frankfurt airports to Cologne is to travel by train.

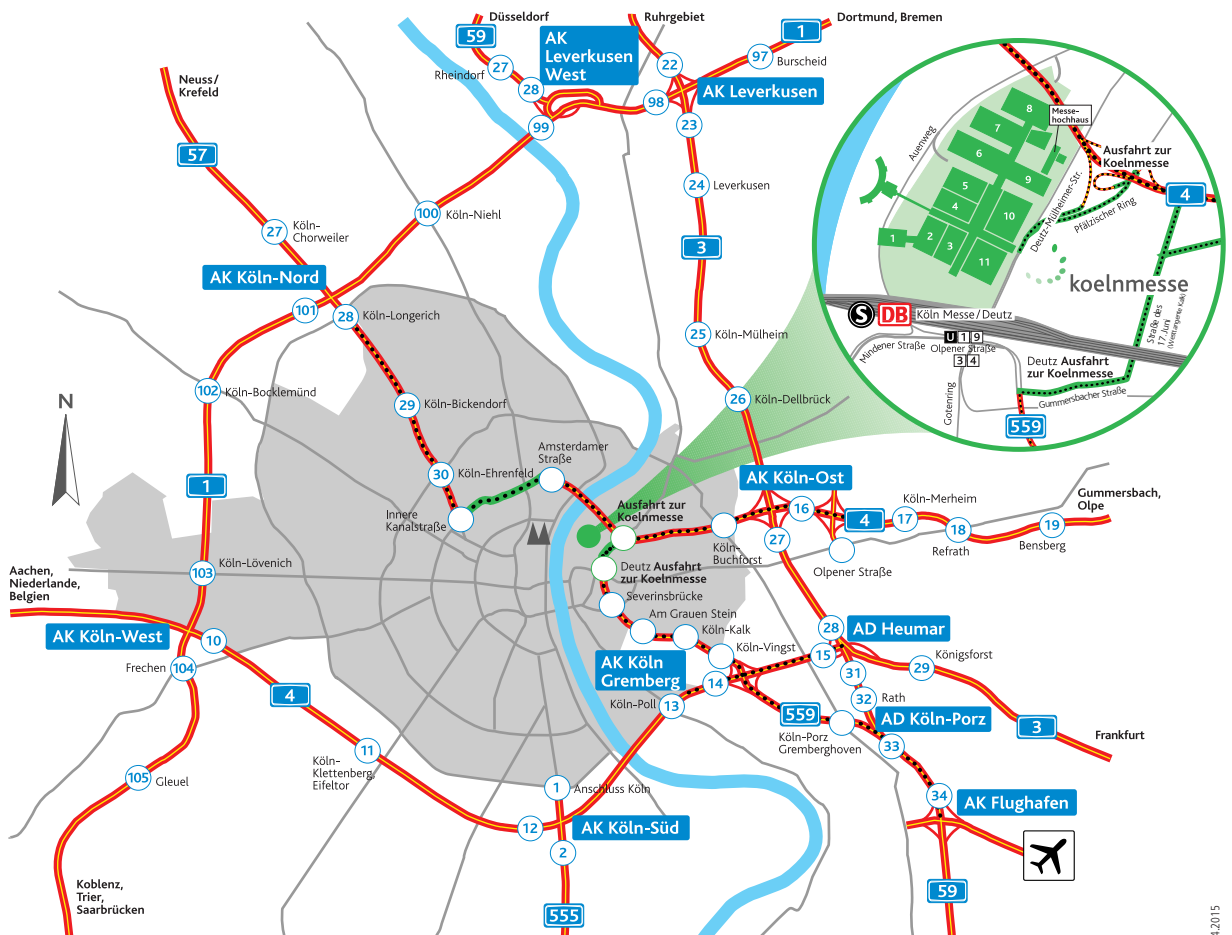
Frankfurt/Main Airport → Cologne approx. 50 min.

Cologne-Bonn Airport → Cologne approx. 12 min.

Düsseldorf Airport → Cologne approx. 45 min.

Arriving by Car

Ten highways lead into Cologne's beltway, which brings you directly to the exhibition center without junctions or traffic lights. Simply follow the green signs marked "Koelnmesse".

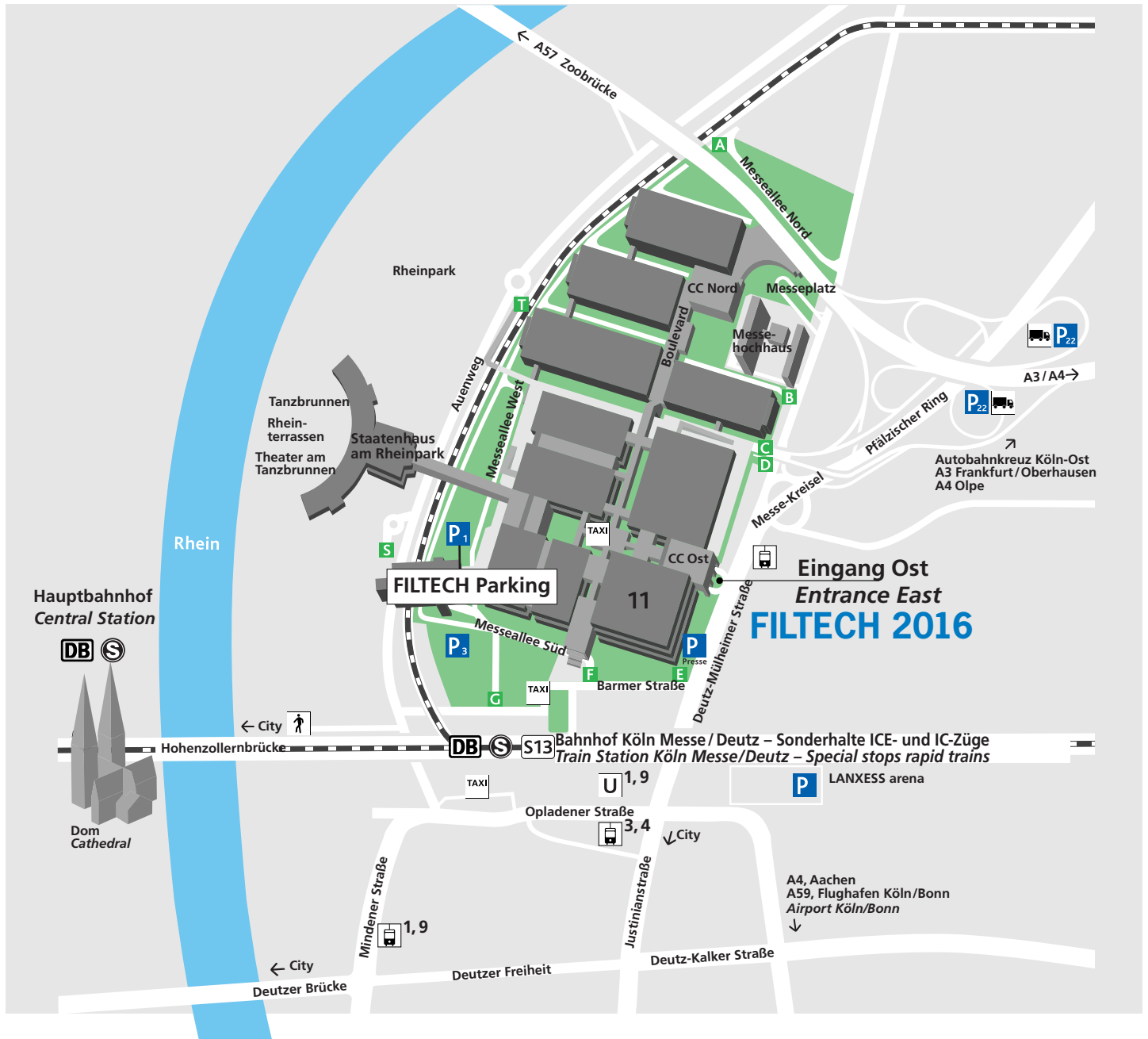

Umweltzone Köln: Zufahrt zur Koelnmesse

Cologne's Low Emission Zone: access routes to Koelnmesse



Seit dem 01.01.2008 ist die Kölner Innenstadt Umweltzone, in die nur noch Fahrzeuge der Schadstoffgruppen 2 bis 4, die entsprechende Plaketten tragen, einfahren dürfen (www.stadt-koeln.de). Die Zufahrt zur Koelnmesse ist für alle Fahrzeuge auch ohne Plakette gesichert. Die Zu- und Abfahrtswege gehen aus der Grafik hervor.

Eine direkte Weiterfahrt außerhalb dieser Routen beispielsweise in die Kölner Innenstadt ist nur noch mit entsprechend gekennzeichneten Fahrzeugen gestattet. Messeteilnehmer aus dem In- und Ausland mit entsprechend ausgerüsteten Fahrzeugen erhalten die Plakette, die Ihnen die Einfahrt in die Umweltzone erlaubt, unter www.umwelt-plakette.de.

Effective 1st January 2008, Cologne's downtown area was declared an "low emission zone". This means that only vehicles with one of the stickers for Emissions Groups 2 to 4 are allowed to enter the downtown area (www.stadt-koeln.de). The Koelnmesse exhibition centre will remain accessible for all types of vehicles, even if they do not bear one of the aforementioned stickers. The graphic shows all of the routes for driving to and from the exhibition centre.

However, only vehicles that bear the pertinent sticker will be allowed to drive outside of these routes (to get to downtown Cologne, for example). Trade fair visitors from Germany and abroad who wish to come to Cologne in an appropriately equipped vehicle will receive a sticker that allows them to drive into the environmental zone after applying at www.umwelt-plakette.de.
